To: David Whitbeck, Constable of the Town of Mount Washington, in said County.

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on Wednesday , the 19th day of October 2022, at 7:00 p.m., then and there to act upon the following article:


Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the move of the North Schoolhouse from its current location at 119 West St., Mount Washington, MA to a site in Garrett Gardens, on East St. in Mount Washington. If authorized, the move will be subject to the following conditions:

- The Town must first receive a matching Capital Grant from the Mass Cultural Council. This grant will be used together with private contributions to pay for the entire project,
- No Taxpayer funds are to be used for the move and renovation of the Schoolhouse at the new site, and
- All required permitting is obtained in order to be in compliance with the Town's Zoning Bylaws, prior to commencement of the project.


