Forty-four of the Town's one hundred twenty-three registered voters cast their ballots. Poll workers were: David Whitbeck, Constable; Gail Garrett, Town Clerk; Judy Whitbeck, Nancy Wright, Harry Garrett, Barbara Greenberg and Brian Tobin. Mary King Austin was also present from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m.

There were no provisional or challenged ballots cast. There were fifty official ballots printed, 44 cast, two were used as specimens and 4 unspoiled at the close of polls.
