Doings of the State Election November 4, 2014

The polls were declared open at 7:00 am by David O. Whitbeck, Constable. Of the Town's one-hundred twenty-five registered voters 76 cast their ballots. Of the 250 ballots delivered 73 were cast and 177 were unspoiled. Of the 50 Absentee Ballots delivered, 47 were unspoiled, 3 were cast over the counter. There were no ballots cast on the ESS machine. There were 50 ESS ballots delivered and all but one unspoiled, as one was used as a test ballot. Poll workers were: David O. Whitbeck, Constable; Gail Garrett, Town Clerk; Morgan Bulkeley; Alexander Lord; Nancy Bott; Robert Bott; Eleanor Wilkinson and Brian Tobin. There were no provisional or challenged ballots cast. There were no marked ballots that were not cast. The ballot box counter started at zero and ended at 76.
