

DOINGS OF THE ANNUAL TOWN ELECTION—MAY 10, 2011

The polls were declared open at 12:00 noon by David O. Whitbeck, Constable.

Eighty-five of the Town's one hundred twenty-seven registered voters cast their ballots. . Poll workers were: David Whitbeck, Constable; Thomas Furcht, Town Clerk; Patricia Verones; Nancy Wright; Jeb Rong; Robert and Nancy Bott; Morgan Bulkeley; Eleanor Dawson; Dorothy Bonbrake; Elizabeth Kasevich; Cory Hines; Judy Isacoff-Waggaman; Philip Garrett; and Mary King Austin. There were no provisional or challenged ballots cast. There were one-hundred official ballots printed, eighty-two cast and eighteen unspoiled at the close of polls. There were ten absentee ballots printed, two voted over the counter and cast, and eight unspoiled at the close of polls. There were fifty ES&S ballots printed, four used as test ballots, and forty-six unspoiled at the close of the polls. There was one FWAB (Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot) cast via fax from overseas. It was a picture perfect Spring day—temp around 70, light breeze, blue skies; the only spoiler was the mass of May flies buzzing about.

The ballot box counter started at zero and ended at eighty-five. There were eighty-five names checked off on the check in list and eighty-four checked off on the check out list (William Short was not checked out although he did vote).

Gerald Alan declined to accept his write-in win as Auditor.
