Violation of these ordinances, bylaws, rules or regulations may be enforced in the manner provided in M.G.L.A. C. 40, § 21D. The enforcement agent(s) shall be members of the Board

of Selectmen, except for all recycling bylaws, which shall be enforced by members of the Board of Health.

### ARTICLE III

#### Adoption of Code

[Adopted 5-2-1995 Annual Town Meeting, Art. 10]

[Article 10, passed 5-2-1995 by the Annual Town Meeting, reads as follows: "The vote was unanimous to authorize the Select Board to accept the renumbering of the various bylaws approved by Town Meeting from their original numbering to the numbering, codification, arrangement, sequence and captions as set forth in the Compilation of Legislation of the Town of Mount Washington, dated 1994, and published by General Code Publishers Corp. of Rochester, New York; said compilation having been done under the direction of the Select Board, Town Counsel and the Town Clerk and being a compilation of the present bylaws of the town and having no substantive changes or deletions in the text thereof, or taken any other action in relation thereto."]

1. ANNUAL TOWN MEETING--MAY 5, 1998

2. Article 12: The Town shall levy a penalty of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars to any person violating the mandatory recycling by-law or any other specific ordinance, by-law, rules or regulations of the Town of Mount Washington. Violation of these ordinances, by-laws, rules or regulations may be enforced in the manner provided in Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, Section 21D. The enforcement agent(s) shall be members of the Board of Selectmen, except for all recycling by-laws which shall be enforced by members of the Board of Health. (Motion--Phil Garrett, Second--Barnett Goldstein)
