ARTICLE I  
**Burials**

[Adopted 2-5-1962 Annual Town Meeting, Art. 17]

- § 127-1. **Limited to residents and taxpayers; exceptions.**

In view of the present lack of space in the town cemeteries, from now on, burial therein is limited to residents or taxpayers of the Town of Mount Washington and their immediate families until further space is available. The Cemetery Committee, by a majority vote, can make exceptions to this rule.

- § 127-2. **Responsibilities of Cemetery Committee.**

It is also requested that the Cemetery Committee find out how other towns operate their cemeteries and also have said Committee try to obtain more land.

ARTICLE II  
**Establishment of Fees**

**§ 127-3. Authorization.**

The Board of Selectmen, with the Cemetery Committee, is authorized to establish fees for cemeteries.

ARTICLE III  
**Nonresidents**  
[Adopted 9-21-1987 Special Town Meeting, Art. 3]

**§ 127-4. Fees.**

A fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.) is set for a cemetery plot of five by ten (5 x 10) feet to a person, who is not a resident or taxpayer in the Town of Mount Washington, but is in direct relationship, mother, father, son or daughter, to a resident or taxpayer of said town, and also the conveyance fee of eighty dollars (\$80.) or cost thereof is set for the purchase of four (4) cornerstones at the time of plot selection.

**§ 127-5. Cornerstones.**

Cornerstones will be purchased and seated into place by the Cemetery Committee.
