ARTICLE I Snowplowing [Adopted 2-5-1968 Annual Town Meeting, Art. 21]

§ 138-1. Discontinuance by town.

The town will discontinue the snowplowing of private driveways.

ARTICLE II Construction of Private Driveways and Roads [Adopted 2-2-1970 Annual Town Meeting, Art. 14]

§ 138-2. Abutters of public way to assume costs; exception.

The abutters of any town public way shall assume all costs and responsibility of the construction of all private roads or driveways to such property. This is to include culverts, surfacing, if deemed necessary, and construction to grade as designated in the field by the Superintendent of Streets who is to be notified, and written approval issued, prior to any such construction, except for Chapter 90 new construction. When the town is reconstructing a road under the provisions of a Chapter 90 construction contract, the town is responsible for all costs necessary to provide a suitable connection between the private way and the town road.
