§ 162-1. Acceptance of statutory provisions.

The town accepts the provisions and enacts a town bylaw of M.G.L.A. C. 40, § 57.

§ 162-2. Refusal of application, revocation or suspension for failure to pay taxes or fees.

Section 57 indicates that any city and town which accepts the provisions of said section may deny any application for or revoke or suspend any local license or permit, including renewals and transfers issued by any board, officer or department for any person, corporation or business enterprise who has neglected or refused to pay any local taxes, fees, assessments, betterments or any other municipal charges.
