§ 206-1. License required.

No person or entity, corporate or otherwise, as owner or as one in control of a premises, shall keep in public view in any area of the Town of Mount Washington any abandoned or junk automobile, vehicle or trailer, as defined in the following section, without being licensed to do so under this chapter.

§ 206-2. Definitions.

For the purpose of this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

ABANDONED OR JUNK AUTOMOBILE, VEHICLE OR TRAILER — One which is unregistered, worn out, cast off or discarded and which is ready for dismantling or destruction or which has been collected or stored for salvage or for stripping in order to make use of parts thereof. Any parts from such a vehicle shall be considered an “abandoned or junk automobile, vehicle, or trailer” under this chapter.

§ 206-3. Request for license.

A license to keep one (1) or more abandoned or junk automobiles, vehicles or trailers shall be requested from the Selectmen who may issue a special permit.
