§ 48-1. Selectman to be employee; compensation.

The Selectmen are permitted to appoint one (1) member of their Board to be employed by the Highway Department, when needed, and to fix his compensation at six dollars (\$6.) per hour.

§ 48-2. Certain work to be offered to residents.

Any non-bid work or contracts offered by the Town of Mount Washington, its officials or its agents must first be offered to qualified residents of the town before nonresidents can be considered or hired.
