§ 54-1. Insurance authorized; exceptions.

Pursuant to MGL C. 258, § 9, as inserted by Chapter 512 of the Acts of 1978, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.) is raised and appropriated to effect insurance providing indemnity for each officer and employee of the town, including the School Department, from personal financial loss and expense, including legal fees if any, arising out of any claim, action, award, compromise, settlement or judgment by reason of an intentional tort or by reason of any act or omission which constitutes a violation of the civil rights of any person under federal or state law is raised and effected, if such employee or officer at the time of such intentional tort or such act or omission was acting within the scope of his official duties or employment, and provided that no such employee or officer shall be indemnified for violation of any such civil rights if he acted in a grossly negligent, willful or malicious manner.
