The Board of Selectmen is empowered to appoint a three-person Waste Disposal Committee, pursuant to M.G.L.A. C. 40, § 44A.

Mount Washington accepted the provisions of an Act establishing the Southern Berkshire Solid Waste Management District, providing for the establishment of a regional solid waste management district in accordance with the provisions of the agreement “Southern Berkshire Solid Waste Management District Agreement” placed before the voters of the town concurrently.
